

Frequent IRS Issued Notices



CP2000 Underreported Income
IRS believes you didn't report all income (e.g., 1099 or W-2 mismatch).

CP501 Balance Due Reminder
First reminder that you owe tax — sent before collections begin.

CP503 Second Balance Due Notice
Follow-up to CP501 if you haven't paid or responded.

CP504 Final Notice Before Levy
IRS intends to levy (seize) assets if you don't respond/pay.

Letter 1058 | LT11 Final Notice of Intent to Levy and Your Right to a Hearing
Legally required notice before enforced collection actions begin (e.g., wage garnishment).

CP90 Intent to Levy (Social Security)
IRS intends to levy your Social Security benefits.

CP14 First Notice of Balance Due
The very first bill for unpaid taxes after return is processed.

Letter 226-J Employer Shared Responsibility Payment (ACA Penalty)
Sent to employers (usually ALEs) who may owe a penalty under the Affordable Care Act.

Letter 5071C Identity Verification Request
IRS suspects identity theft and wants you to verify your identity.

CP21A / CP21B Adjustment Notices
IRS made changes to your return (e.g., refund increase or decrease).
